## **FOCUS ON WORSHIP**

WORSHIP DURING THE SEASON OF EASTER: Easter is the celebration of the Resurrection of Christ, the "queen of feasts," of the Church year. Easter celebrates an event so great that it cannot be limited to one day. Thus, Easter consists of fifty days--a "week of weeks." Beginning with the Vigil of Easter and continuing through-out the Easter season, up to Pentecost Sunday. The candelabras are lit; and the lighted Paschal Candle is appropriately placed near the Gospel side of the altar. The theme of the season is the Resurrection of Christ, looking towards Christ's Restoration to His Heavenly Glory. The resurrection of Jesus, which Easter celebrates, is a foundation of the Christian faith. – The resurrection established Jesus as the Son of God and is cited as proof that God will judge the world in righteousness. God has given Christians "a new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead". Christians, through faith in the working of God are spiritually resurrected with Jesus so that they may walk in a new way of life.

PASCHAL CANDLE: The Paschal candle is placed in the chancel and lighted for each liturgy during the 50 days of Easter. At times other than the Easter season, the Paschal candle is kept in its stand near the baptismal font as a visual reminder of the connection between Baptism and Easter. It is lighted for each celebration of Baptism.

ASCENSION: The Ascension of Our Lord celebrates the bodily ascension of Jesus into heaven following his resurrection. This Christian teaching found in the New Testament that the resurrected Jesus was taken up to Heaven in his resurrected body, in the presence of eleven of his apostles, occurring 40 days after the resurrection. In the bible narrative, an angel tells the watching disciples that Jesus' second coming will take place in the same manner as his ascension. Ascension is professed in the Nicene Creed and Apostles' Creed.





# ST. LUKE LUTHERAN SPRING HIKE Saturday, April 13, 2024

2.2 miles of the HIGH BRIDGE TRAIL, Outside of Farmville, 65 miles from St. Luke. Parking at 555 River Road, Farmville, VA 23901 (GPS) Parking Lot for High Bridge Trail.

We will meet at St. Luke to carpool at 9:15am or meet at the High Bridge Parking Lot (555 River Rd, Farmville) at 10:30am. We will be hiking 2.2 miles to the bridge and back. Bring a water bottle!

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

High Bridge Trail is 31 miles long and ideally suited for hiking, bicycling and horseback riding. Once a rail bed, the trail is wide, level and generally flat. Its finely crushed limestone surface and dimensions make it easy to enjoy. The park's centerpiece is the majestic High Bridge, which is more than 2,400 feet long and 125 feet above the Appomattox River. It is the longest recreational bridge in Virginia and among the longest in the United States. High Bridge, a Virginia Historic Landmark, is on the National Register of Historic Places. The trail is a National Recreation Trail recognizing exemplary trails of local and regional significance, connecting people to nature, to each other, and to our shared history and culture. Please bring drinking water because none is available on the trail.

#### **TO PARK**

West of the bridge: River Road, Farmville (Cumberland County) Use 555 River Road, Farmville, VA 23901, to get here. High Bridge is nearly a mile from the lot. After hiking, we will gather at Charley's Waterfront Café, 201 Mill Street, Farmville.

If you're not hiking, join us at Charley's for lunch! We should be ready for lunch around 1:00pm.


